Requirements to Obtain Real Estate Agent/Salesperson License

- Minimum Age Requirements: 18 years old
- Minimum Education Requirements: High School Diploma or its equivalent
- Residency: Be a resident of Puerto Rico for a minimum of 1 year prior to making application
- Reputation Requirements: Complete a signed affidavit Certificate of Moral Reputation
- Pre-Licensing Requirements: 60 hours- Salesperson Pre-Licensing Course
- Knowledge exam: Complete and pass real estate knowledge exam once prelicensing courses have been completed
- **Bonding Requirements:** Submit copy of \$10,000 bond that must have a 4 year effective length
- Application: Complete application and remit application fee
- Renewal Requirements: Complete real estate course requirements and license renewal steps per state requirements

Requirements to Obtain Real Estate Broker License

- Minimum Education Requirements: Must have completed a minimum of 60 college/university credits
- Residency: Be a resident of Puerto Rico for a minimum of 1 year prior to making application

- Reputation Requirements: Complete a signed affidavit Certificate of Moral Reputation
- **Experience Qualifications:** Must have 2 years licensed real estate sales experience in the preceding 5 years
- Educational Requirements: 90 hours- Broker Pre-Licensing Course
- **Broker Knowledge Exam:** Complete and pass broker knowledge exam once educational courses have been completed
- **Bonding Requirements:** Submit copy of \$10,000 bond that must have a 4 year effective length
- **Escrow Account:** Brokers must submit evidence of having an Escrow Account (Trust Account), if Brokerage will elect to have an Escrow Account
- Application: Complete application and remit application fee
- Renewal Requirements: Complete real estate course requirements and license renewal steps per state requirements
